Greetings from the Montreal Headquarters of the Canadian Improv Games!

Our 2011 season is here and under way! If you aren't familiar with our organization, or it's been a while since you've seen us, please feel free to give us a call or find us online at improv.ca/montreal. Registration has begun and we hope to hear from you!

When you register, your school will receive:

- The Canadian Improv Games' training DVD and the Coaches Companion Training Manual
- A group workshop with other teams from your area led by a Canadian Improv Games trainer AND one private training session at your school
- Entry into the Montreal Regional Tournament, February 15-18, 2012
 - The top 5 teams advance to the Finals on Saturday, February 18th, 2012.
 - The winner of the finals advances to the National Tournament & Festival in Ottawa, April 3-7, 2012.



Registration for the Montreal Regional Tournament is **\$250 per team**. Each school is permitted to enter a single team in the regional tournament. Opportunities for one additional team per school can be found in our Junior Tournament!

Back for its 2nd season, the **Junior Tournament** is an opportunity to enter a team of up to 8 students from grades 7-10 which will compete on it's own night with other Junior Teams from the region. The format for the Junior Tournament is slightly different from that of the Regional Tournament and can be found in your Training Manual.

Registration for the Junior Tournament is **half price at \$125!**

In summary, now in Montreal any school can enter the Regional Tournament, the Junior Tournament or a team in each!
